CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS SUBMITTED BY STATES PARTIES
UNDER ARTICLE 19 OF THE CONVENTION

Second periodic reports of States parties due in 1998

Note by the Secretary-General

1. In accordance with article 19, paragraph 1, of the Convention against Torture and Other Cruel, Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment, the States parties shall submit to the Committee against Torture, through the Secretary-General of the United Nations, reports on the measures they have taken to give effect to their undertakings under the Convention, within one year after the entry into force of the Convention for the State party concerned. Thereafter the States parties shall submit supplementary reports every four years on any new measures taken and such other reports as the Committee may request.

2. Accordingly, the first supplementary (second periodic) reports under article 19, paragraph 1, of the Convention are due in 1998 from eight States parties on the following dates:

Antigua and Barbuda	17 August 1998
Armenia	12 October 1998
Burundi	19 March 1998
Costa Rica	10 December 1998
Mauritius	7 January 1998
Morocco	20 July 1998
Slovakia	27 May 1998
Slovenia	14 August 1998

3. The reports received from the States parties listed above will be issued as addenda to this document.
