NOTE VERBALE DATED 12 MARCH 1998 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION
OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO
THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of the Marshall Islands to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 864 (1993) concerning the situation in Angola and has the honour to refer to his note SCA/2/98 (4), dated 6 March 1998. The Permanent Mission of the Republic of the Marshall Islands wishes to advise that appropriate national legal measures have been taken by the Marshall Islands Government in order to give effect to the provisions set out in paragraph 4 of Security Council resolution 1127 (1997) of 28 August 1997, brought into effect by resolution 1135 (1997) of 29 October 1997.

The Government of the Marshall Islands looks forward to receiving from the Committee the list of officials and adult members of their immediate families, as well as the list of aircraft registered in Angola and other pertinent information on this matter, for the purpose of fully implementing the said resolution.
