Letter dated 10 March 1998 from the Minister for Foreign Affairs
of El Salvador addressed to the Secretary-General

It is our pleasure to express to you the appreciation of the people and Government of El Salvador and to extend their congratulations to you for the successful use of your good offices in bringing about a peaceful negotiated solution to the current Iraq crisis.

Your timely and wise action truly demonstrated that situations such as this can be resolved through the diplomatic channel and engender total confidence in the United Nations as an entity for guaranteeing the peaceful settlement of conflicts between States.

We hope that the Government of Iraq fulfils the commitments made to you and the Security Council in order to avoid a possible armed confrontation, which would destabilize harmony and world peace.

The Government of the Republic of El Salvador will carefully follow the progress made towards a settlement of this dispute, in the hope that the necessary resources will continue to be used in order to bring about its felicitous resolution.
