<u>Letter dated 31 March 1998 from the President of Nicaragua</u> addressed to the Secretary-General

The Government of the Republic of Nicaragua was pleased to hear of the successful outcome of your peace efforts in Iraq. The Government over which I preside firmly supports any diplomatic solution to the current crisis in Iraq and emphasizes the urgent need for that country to comply with all the Security Council resolutions and to permit access to the Presidential sites, in accordance with the demands of the international community.

Confident that what you are doing to further peaceful aims in the world will result in an appropriate solution to the Iraq crisis, I take this opportunity to convey to you the renewed assurances of my highest consideration.
