II. Annotations to the provisional agenda

Item 1 - Election of officers

It is recommended that the Expert Meeting elect a Chairman and a Vice-Chairman-cum-Rapporteur.

The Expert Meeting will have three working days to complete its business. Capacity-building in the area of electronic commerce: human resource Item 3 development

The experts will address the issue of "Capacity-building in the area of electronic commerce: human resource development", for which a background paper (TD/B/COM.3/EM.6/2) has been prepared by the UNCTAD secretariat. divided into four sections. The first underlines the importance of human resources development in the context of the emerging global information economy, while the second focuses more specifically on training and information needs in the area of electronic commerce. In the third section, the comparative advantages of UNCTAD in addressing these training needs are examined. The last section describes a few concrete proposals on how such comparative advantages could be used to the benefit of member States. It is expected that discussions will focus on this last aspect, and that experts will help UNCTAD to identify areas in which it could propose practical solutions to the most urgent training needs of its member States in the domain of electronic commerce, and propose ways in which various parts of civil society could be mobilized to contribute the design, production and dissemination of such solutions. Such discussions would be particularly useful in the context of preparations for the first meeting of Parners for Development, to be held in Lyon (France) in November 1998.
