LETTER DATED 28 APRIL 1998 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that 2,826 mines, bombs, missiles and other ordnance left behind by the 30-Power aggression against Iraq were found and disposed of in various parts of Iraq between 1 February and 31 March 1998. The items included cluster bombs, spherical bombs, air-launched bombs and anti-personnel mines. They were found in the following governorates: Ninawa, Basrah, Anbar, Baghdad, Muthanna, Wasit, Najaf, Maysan, Babil, Ta'mim and Diyala.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
