SECURITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION 1160 (1998)

Note verbale dated 23 April 1998 from the Permanent Mission of Norway to the United Nations addressed to the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Norway to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1160 (1998), and has the honour to inform the Committee in relation to paragraph 12 of that resolution that, on 17 April 1998, Norway adopted national regulations prohibiting the sale or supply to the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, including Kosovo, by Norwegian nationals or from Norwegian territory, of arms and related material, such as weapons and ammunition, military vehicles and equipment and spare parts for the aforementioned.

The prohibition includes sale or supply by the use of Norwegian registered vessels or aircraft.

The regulations equally prohibit arming and training for terrorist activities in the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia.
