## <u>Draft decision submitted by the Chairman following</u> informal consultations

The General Assembly, having considered the reports of the Secretary-General  $^1$  and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions:  $^2$ 

- (a) Takes note of the report of the Secretary-General on the final disposition of the assets of the United Nations Peace Forces $^3$  and requests the Board of Auditors to examine the report in the light of the views expressed by Member States thereon; $^4$
- [(b) Expresses its serious concern regarding the observation of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions in paragraph 6 of its report $^5$  regarding the use of gratis personnel as negotiators for the United Nations for wet-lease arrangements;]

- (c) Decides that in future detailed information and justification on written off and lost items should be provided in reports on the final disposition of assets of all peacekeeping operations;
- (d) Decides also to defer consideration of the treatment of the unencumbered balance arising in respect of the period from 1 July 1996 to 30 June 1997 pending the submission of the final performance report for the United Nations Peace Forces.
