#### I. INTRODUCTION

- 1. The previous recommendation made by the Fifth Committee to the General Assembly on the question of the proposed United Nations Code of Conduct appears in the report of the Committee on agenda item 114, contained in document A/52/746/Add.1.
- 2. The Fifth Committee resumed its consideration of the question of the proposed United Nations Code of Conduct at its 67th and 68th meetings, on 28 and 29 May 1998, under items 114, 153 and 157. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the items are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/52/SR.67 and 68).
- 3. In addition to the documents listed in A/52/746/Add.1, the Committee had before it the addendum to the report of the International Civil Service Commission for the year 1997 (A/52/30/Add.1).

## II. CONSIDERATION OF A DRAFT DECISION PROPOSED BY THE CHAIRMAN

4. At the 68th meeting, on 29 May, the Chairman of the Committee orally proposed a draft decision, by which the General Assembly would defer consideration of the proposed United Nations Code of Conduct to the third part of its resumed fifty-second session.

5. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted the draft decision without a vote (see para. 6).

### III. RECOMMENDATION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

6. The Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decision:

# Proposed United Nations Code of Conduct

The General Assembly decides to defer consideration of the question of the proposed United Nations Code of Conduct to the third part of its resumed fifty-second session.
