LETTER DATED 29 JUNE 1998 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

According to information received from officials of the Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran, on 2 February 1998 at 2200 hours, a United States warship aggressed into the territorial waters of the Islamic Republic of Iran and, at the position of N2951 and E4952, anchored itself 8 1/2 miles inside the territorial waters of the Islamic Republic of Iran, without heeding the warnings coming from the Islamic Republic of Iran.

On 3 February 1998 at 0110 hours, eight United States tugboats violated the territorial waters of the Islamic Republic of Iran and stopped around an Iranian destroyer. One came close to the destroyer.

The Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran protests the entry of the United States warship and tugboats into the territorial waters of the Islamic Republic of Iran, actions which are in clear violation of international laws and regulations, as well as the fact that the warship ignored all warnings coming from the Islamic Republic of Iran. The Islamic Republic of Iran expects that activities such as these will not be repeated again.
