SECURITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED
PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION 1160 (1998)

Note verbale dated 28 April 1998 from the Permanent Mission
of Germany to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman
of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Germany to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1160 (1998) and, with reference to paragraph 12 of that resolution, has the honour to inform him as follows.

By its common position of 26 February 1996, the European Union instituted an arms embargo, inter alia, against the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia. The arms embargo is implemented in a way to ensure that no arms exports are permitted by the competent authorities. Arms exports without administrative permission are punishable under law.

Security Council resolution 1160 (1998) of 31 March 1998 established an arms embargo of the same scope as the aforementioned common position of the European Union, so that additional implementation measures are not necessary.
