### IMPLEMENTATION OF GENERAL ASSEMBLY RESOLUTIONS 50/227 AND 52/12 B

Draft resolution submitted by the Vice-President of the  
Council, Mr. Anwarul Chowdhury (Bangladesh) on the basis  
of informal consultations

Further measures for the restructuring and revitalization  
of the United Nations in the economic, social and related  
fields

The Economic and Social Council,

Taking into account its resolution E/1998/L.18 and annexes I to III thereto,

Bearing in mind that the Council will hold, at its resumed substantive session of 1998, elections for the composition of the bodies referred to in annex 1 of the resolution, so that these bodies are fully constituted from 1 January 1999,

1. Decides to terminate, as of 31 December 1998, the current membership of the Commission on Science and Technology for Development, the Committee for Development Planning, the Committee on Natural Resources and the Committee on New and Renewable Sources of Energy and on Energy for Development;

2. Also decides to hold new elections for the thirty-three members of the Commission on Science and Technology for Development, in accordance with the pattern for regional distribution agreed upon<sup>1</sup> following the election of the new members, there will be a drawing of lots for all seats whether vacant or not to stagger the terms of office; sixteen members of the Commission will serve for a

term of two years (African States - four members; Asian States - three members; Latin American and Caribbean States - three members; Eastern European States - two members; Western European and other States - four members) and seventeen members will serve for a term of four years (African States - four members; Asian States - four members; Latin American and Caribbean States - three members; Eastern European States - two members; Western European and other States - four members);

3. Further decides that, in accordance with previous practice, the terms of all the members of the Committee for Development Planning will be concurrent;

4. Decides that the election for the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources for Development will be held every four years and the terms of all the members will be concurrent.
