NOTE VERBALE DATED 4 AUGUST 1998 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF GERMANY TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE

The Permanent Mission of Germany to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 864 (1993) concerning the situation in Angola and has the honour to inform the Chairman of the measures that Germany has taken with regard to paragraphs 11 and 12 of resolution 1173 (1998), as requested by paragraph 4 of resolution 1176 (1998).

Germany has implemented the provisions required by Security Council resolution 1173 (1998) within the framework of a regulation of the European Union. The European Union has adopted a Common Position on this matter on 3 July 1998.
