LETTER DATED 7 AUGUST 1998 FROM THE CHAIRMAN OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION 1132 (1997) CONCERNING SIERRA LEONE ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to resolution 1171 (1998), adopted by the Security Council on 5 June 1998, concerning Sierra Leone. In paragraph 4 of the resolution, the Committee is required to report to the Council on notifications received from States on the export of arms and related <u>matériel</u> to Sierra Leone, as well as on notifications of imports of arms and related <u>matériel</u> made by the Government of Sierra Leone.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that the Committee established pursuant to resolution 1132 (1997) concerning Sierra Leone received notifications on 9 and 18 June 1998 from the Government of Germany for the export of 20 Volkswagen Iltis vehicles to the police forces of Sierra Leone through the entry point of Queen Elisabeth II Quay, Freetown.
