IDENTICAL LETTERS DATED 18 AUGUST 1998 FROM THE PERMANENT
REPRESENTATIVE OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE
UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL AND TO
THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to welcome the timely statement by the President of the Security Council to the press on 13 August 1998 on the "continuing escalation of the armed conflict in Afghanistan caused by the Taliban forces' offensive in northern Afghanistan", in which the President said in part:

"The Security Council is deeply concerned at the reports of the capture by the Taliban of the Consulate General of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Mazar-e-Sharif and the rough treatment of its personnel. It strongly warns the perpetrators of this flagrant violation of the recognized norms and principles of international law against causing any further harm to their captives and demands the immediate release of the personnel of the Consulate General of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Mazar-e-Sharif, as well as of the Islamic Republic News Agency (IRNA) correspondent in that city."

In addition to the 11 personnel of the Consulate General of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Mazar-e-Sharif and the IRNA correspondent, 36 Iranian relief workers carrying foodstuffs in trucks have also been detained by the Taliban forces on the day of the offensive campaign against that city on 8 August 1998. They have all been reportedly transferred to Kandahar. The names of all detainees are herewith attached as an annex to the present letter.

It may be pointed out that at the outset of the Taliban offensive campaign to the north of Afghanistan, the Islamic Republic of Iran had sought assurances from the Government of Pakistan that the security of the Consulate-General of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Mazar-e-Sharif and the integrity and safety of its personnel would not be violated.

I wish to report, with extreme concern, that as of this morning the Taliban leaders have not been forthcoming and there has been no progress towards the resolution of this highly serious problem.

The Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran regards further delay in the release of its nationals totally unacceptable. It is ultimately responsible for the safety and security of its nationals and is fully prepared to live up to its responsibility. The Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran nevertheless wishes to see its nationals released unharmed and expeditiously without any further delay through negotiation and in an amicable fashion.

Hence, the Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran calls upon the Secretary-General and the Security Council to continue to regard this issue as vitally important and to use the good offices of the United Nations to impress upon the Taliban, and the Governments in a position to assist, in ensuring the safety and immediate release of the Iranian captives.

It would be highly appreciated if the text of the present letter and its annex were circulated as a document of the Security Council.
