Administrative and budgetary aspects of the financing of the United Nations peacekeeping operations: financing of the United Nations peacekeeping operations

Death and disability benefits

Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. The information contained in the annex to the present note is submitted pursuant to paragraphs 16 and 17 of General Assembly resolution 51/239 A of 17 June 1997, in which the Assembly noted that, as at 19 May 1997, a backlog of 564 death and disability claims awaited processing and requested the Secretary-General to submit to the Assembly quarterly written reports on the progress made in clearing the backlog.
- 2. In this connection, it should also be recalled that in the same resolution the General Assembly provided general temporary assistance resources funded from the support account in the amount of \$158,500 for the 12-month period from 1 July 1997 to 30 June 1998 for the sole purpose of processing the backlog of claims referred to in paragraph 1 above. In this regard, it is noted that in view of the progress that has been made in dealing with the backlog, when submitting his support account proposals for the period 1 July 1998 to 30 June 1999 (A/52/837), the Secretary-General did not seek continuation of provision of general temporary assistance resources for this purpose.
- 3. The first quarterly report, dated 28 October 1997 (A/52/538), presented information relating to death and disability incidents occurring up to and including 30 June 1997, indicating the total number of claims from the backlog that had been received since 19 May 1997, as well as the number of claims processed as at 30 September 1997. The second quarterly report provided updated information as at 31 December 1997 (A/C.5/52/37), while the third quarterly provided updated information as at 31 March 1998 (A/C.5/52/50).
- 4. The present document constitutes the fourth quarterly report. The information presented in the attached annex indicates the total number of claims received from troop-contributing countries as at 30 June 1998, identifying the number of claims received since 19 May 1997. This information is presented by country (table A) and by peacekeeping operation (table B). A comparison of the total number of incidents of death and disability reported by peacekeeping

operations as at 30 June 1998 and the related number of claims submitted to the Secretariat is presented in table $\rm C.$
