PROPOSAL FOR DRAFT 01 SERIES OF AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION No. 82

(Headlamps (HS2))

Transmitted by the Working Party on Lighting and Light-Signalling (GRE)

Note: The text reproduced below was adopted by the Meeting of Experts on Lighting and Light-Signalling at its fortieth session and is transmitted to the Working Party and to the Administrative Committee (AC.1) for consideration. It is based on document TRANS/WP.29/GRE/R.285, as amended by the Meeting of Experts (TRANS/WP.29/GRE/40, paras. 19 and 20). This amendment is consequential to the Proposal for a new draft Regulation No. [MH] (see document TRANS/WP.29/1998/42).

Insert new paragraphs 13. to 13.7., to read:

- "13. TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS
- 13.1. As from six months after the official date of entry into force of Regulation No. $[MH]^*$ /, Contracting Parties applying this Regulation shall cease to grant ECE approvals according to this Regulation.
- 13.2. Contracting Parties applying this Regulation shall not refuse to grant extensions of approval to this Regulation.
- 13.3. Approvals granted under this Regulation before the date of entry into force of Regulation No. $[MH]^{*}/$ and all extensions of approvals, shall remain valid indefinitely.
- 13.4. Contracting Parties applying this Regulation shall continue to issue approvals for devices (components and separate technical units) on the basis of this Regulation, provided that the devices (components and separate technical units) are intended as replacements for fitting to vehicles in use.
- 13.5. As from the official date of entry into force of Regulation No. [MH]*/, no Contracting Party applying this Regulation shall prohibit the fitting on a new vehicle type of a component or separate technical unit approved under Regulation No. [MH].
- 13.6. Contracting Parties applying this Regulation shall continue to allow fitting on a vehicle type or vehicle of a component or separate technical unit approved to this Regulation.
- 13.7. Contracting Parties applying this Regulation shall continue to allow fitting or use on a vehicle in use of a component or separate technical unit approved to this Regulation as amended by any previous series of amendment provided that the component or separate technical unit is intended for replacement."
