## Article 61

## Notification of the indictment

9. Once the charges have been confirmed in accordance with this article, the Presidency shall constitute a Trial Chamber  $\underline{1}$ / which, subject to paragraph 7 of this article and to article 64 [(4)], shall be responsible for the conduct of subsequent proceedings and may exercise any functions of the Pre-Trial Chamber that are relevant and capable of application in those proceedings.
