## PROPOSAL SUBMITTED BY POLAND

Proposal to clarify the relationship between: Article 57, paragraph 3

<u>Functions of the Pre-Trial Chamber in relation with investigation</u> <u>and</u> <u>Article 69, paragraph 6</u>

## <u>Evidence</u>

1. Delete article 57, paragraph 3.

2. Add the following sentence at the end of the current paragraph 6 of article 69:

"The Court may refuse to admit evidence obtained as a result or consequence of a breach of or non-compliance with an [order] [recommendation][order and recommendation] of the Pre-Trial Chamber."1/
