1. At its 53rd meeting, on 24 November 1981, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/36/58) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolutions A/36/L.20 and A/36/L.21. The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.

2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/36/SR.53).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, [by 73 votes to 1, with 8 abstentions], to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolutions A/36/L.20 and A/36/L.21, an additional appropriation of \$25,000 would be required under section 27 of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1982-1983.
