1. New Zealand has never participated in trade sanctions against Cuba, nor applied the laws or measures referred to in the note from the Secretary-General.
 2. New Zealand prefers that the imposition of trade embargoes should be in accordance with international law and should not be broadened unilaterally to encompass third countries and their nationals.
