Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 66th and 67th meetings, on 8 December 1981, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/36/77) on the administrative and financial implications of the draft resolution recommended by the Sixth Committee in paragraph 13 of its report (A/36/775). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the Sixth Committee in paragraph 13 of its report (A/36/775), an additional appropriation of \$90,000 would be required under section 26 (Legal activities) of the proposed programme budget for 1982-1983.
