LETTER DATED 17 OCTOBER 1998 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF IRAO TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that 21 mines, bombs, missiles and other ordnance left behind by the 1991 30-Power aggression against Iraq were found and disposed of in all parts of the country between 1 August and 30 September 1998. The items included American-made cluster bombs as well as spherical bomblets, strip bombs, aerial bombs and artillery shells, and they were found in the following governorates: Ninawa, Basrah, Najaf, Muthanna, Anbar and Maysan.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
