Letter dated 11 November 1998 from the Director General of the International Atomic Energy Agency addressed to the President of the Security Council

I would like to inform you that, upon consultation with the Secretary-General, I have decided, out of concern for their safety in view of the escalating situation in Iraq, to temporarily relocate to Bahrain all International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) inspectors currently in Baghdad.

This decision was taken in parallel with that of the United Nations Special Commission (UNSCOM), which is also withdrawing its personnel and on whose logistic support the IAEA inspectors are dependent.
