PROPOSALS FOR THE POSSIBLE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PERMANENT
FORUM FOR INDIGENOUS PEOPLE: INFORMATION CONCERNING
FINANCIAL AND SECRETARIAT IMPLICATIONS

Note by the secretariat

1. Under this item, discussion will be held on the financial and secretariat implications of the proposed permanent forum for indigenous people. The present note provides information about the possible costs that might be incurred in relation to conference services, the preparation of documentation, travel of members and staffing.
2. For the purposes of determining the nature of the costs that would be incurred, the secretariat has assumed that the permanent forum would consist, in the first instance, of a two-week annual session which would be held at the United Nations Office at Geneva. It has also been anticipated that the forum would consider up to 100 pages of pre-sessional documentation and prepare a report of up to 60 pages. Documentation and interpretation would be in all working languages of the United Nations. It has also been assumed that some additional secretariat staffing may be necessary to prepare any substantive reports which may be required and to service the session. For this purpose, it may be necessary to contract additional staff on a temporary basis, for example two Professional and one General Service staff for four months. It may also be necessary to include the purchase of equipment such as computers and printers.
3. It has been proposed that the permanent forum might include members representing Governments and indigenous peoples. For the purposes of calculating possible costs relating to the travel and daily subsistence allowance of members of the permanent forum, it has been assumed that the

forum would consist of 20 members, divided equally between indigenous and governmental representatives. As governmental delegations are permanently represented at the United Nations Office at Geneva and at Headquarters, it has been anticipated that there would not be any travel or living allowance expenses associated with their participation as members of the forum. The 10 indigenous members of the forum representing indigenous peoples from all regions on an equitable basis would require a travel and daily subsistence allowance for the duration of the session.

4. On the basis of the hypothetical permanent forum outlined above, the following costs may be anticipated (US\$):

(a)	Conference services for a two-week meeting, including documentation and interpretation	336 878
(b)	Travel of indigenous delegations	39 300
(c)	Daily subsistence allowance of indigenous delegates	35 620
(d)	Additional secretariat staff, two Professionals and one General Service, for four months each	67 200
(e)	Purchase of computer and printer	5 000
	Estimated total:	US\$ 483 998

5. If the proposed permanent forum and the Secretariat are established within the Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights, it would be necessary to determine whether any part or all of the above-mentioned costs would be absorbed by the regular budget of the Office as part of its future programme.
