## Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions

## **Report of the Fifth Committee**

Rapporteur: Mr. Tammam Sulaiman (Syrian Arab Republic)

- 1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 15 September 1998, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fifty-third session the item entitled "Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions".
- 2. At its 20th meeting, on 6 November 1998, the Fifth Committee had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/53/101) concerning the vacancies in the membership of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions that will occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of six of its members on 31 December 1998.
- 3. The Fifth Committee also had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/53/5) containing the names of nine persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment or reappointment to the Advisory Committee for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 1999.
- 4. At the same meeting, the Fifth Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend the appointment of Nazareth A. Incera (Costa Rica) to the Advisory Committee for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 1999.
- 5. The Fifth Committee proceeded to elect by secret ballot three persons from the candidates proposed by the Asian States. The result of the voting was as follows:

- 6. Having obtained the required majority, Fumiaki Toya (Japan), Ahmad Kamal (Pakistan) and Rajat Saha (India) were recommended for appointment as members of the Advisory Committee for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 1999.
- 7. The Fifth Committee then proceeded to elect by secret ballot two persons from the candidates proposed by the Western European and Other States. The result of the voting was as follows:

- 8. Having obtained the required majority, Nicholas A. Thorne (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland) was recommended for appointment as a member of the Advisory Committee for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 1999.
- 9. In accordance with rule 94 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, the Fifth Committee then proceeded to a second ballot, which was restricted to the two candidates who had obtained the greatest number of votes, to fill the remaining vacancy.
- 10. The result of the voting was as follows:
