Observations by the Committee on Conferences in accordance
with paragraph 6 of General Assembly resolution 35/10 A

1. In accordance with paragraph 6 of resolution 35/10 A, by which the General Assembly had decided that all proposals affecting the schedule of conferences and meetings made at sessions of the General Assembly should be reviewed by the Committee on Conferences when administrative implications were being considered under the requirements of rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the Assembly, the Committee on Conferences met to review the implications of the draft resolution contained in document A/SPC/36/L.20. As the Special Political Committee adopted this draft resolution at an earlier meeting the following information is submitted to the Fifth Committee for its consideration.
2. By this draft resolution the General Assembly would request the Special Committee to continue its investigations and would request the Secretary-General to provide all the necessary facilities to the Special Committee.
3. The Committee on Conferences took note of the time-frame during which the Special Committee is expected to meet in 1982. Given the low utilization of conference resources by the Special Committee in 1981, the Committee on Conferences, however, appeals to it to organize its work in a more efficient and economical way.
