NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

At the 42nd plenary meeting of its thirty-sixth session, on 28 October 1981, the General Assembly adopted resolution 36/8, entitled "Implementation of the Programme for the Decade for Action to Combat Racism and Racial Discrimination".* In paragraph 8 of that resolution, the General Assembly

"Again requests the Security Council to consider, as a matter of urgency, the imposition of full mandatory sanctions under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations against the racist régime of South Africa, including, in particular, an embargo on the delivery of oil and oil products to South Africa and the strengthening of the embargo on arms, with a view to putting an end to all military and nuclear collaboration with South Africa."
