Addendum

1. The Trade and Development Board, at its nineteenth executive session, on 15 December 1998, approved the applications of three non-governmental organizations for designation under rule 77 of the rules of procedure of the Board.

2. The following entries should thus be added to the list of non-governmental organizations participating in the work of UNCTAD (see document TD/B/NGO/LIST/2 and Add.1 and Add.2):

3. At the same session, the Board approved the reclassification from the special to the general category of the International Centre for Trade and Sustainable Development, which had been granted status with the Board at its sixteenth executive session.

4. Also at the same session, the Board took note that, in conformity with the provisions of Board decision 43 (VII), sections III and IV, and after consultation with the Government concerned (the Government of India), the Secretary-General had entered the All India Association of Industries in the Register of national non-governmental organizations.

5. Accordingly, the number of non-governmental organizations included in the list now totals 181: 98 in the general category and 83 in the special category. There are 12 national non-governmental organizations included in the Register.

Note

1. Non-governmental organizations in the special category may attend sessions of the Trade and Development Board and sessions of the Commissions and their subsidiary bodies as indicated in this column.
