ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA OF THE THIRTY-SIXTH REGULAR SESSION
OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND ALLOCATION OF ITEMS

Third report of the General Committee

1. At its 4th meeting, on 3 November 1981, the General Committee considered a request submitted by Algeria, Bahrain, Democratic Yemen, Djibouti, Iraq, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Mauritania, Morocco, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Somalia, the Sudan, the Syrian Arab Republic, Tunisia, the United Arab Emirates and Yemen (A/36/243) for the inclusion in the agenda of an additional item entitled:

"Israel's decision to build a canal linking the Mediterranean Sea to the Dead Sea".

In this connexion, the General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly:

- (a) That the item should be included in the agenda;
- (b) That it should be allocated to the Special Political Committee.

2. At the same meeting, the General Committee considered a request submitted by Angola, Jamaica and Nepal (A/36/244 and Add.1) for the inclusion in the agenda of an additional item entitled:

"Equitable representation in the International Law Commission and enlargement of its composition".

In this connexion, the General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly:

- (a) That the item should be included in the agenda;
- (b) That it should be considered directly in plenary meeting before item 17 (f) is taken up.

3. Also at the same meeting, the General Committee considered a request submitted by Jordan (A/36/245) for the inclusion in the agenda of an additional item entitled:

"New international humanitarian order".

In this connexion, the General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly:

- (a) That the item should be included in the agenda;
- (b) That it should be allocated to the Third Committee.
