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**Information circular\***

To: Members of the staff at Headquarters

From: The Assistant Secretary-General for Human Resources Management

Subject: **Revised salary scales for staff in the General Service, Language Teacher, Public Information Assistant, Security Service and Trades and Crafts categories at Headquarters\*\***

1. The current procedure for effecting interim adjustments to the salary scales for staff in the General Service and related categories at Headquarters calls for an adjustment in the net salaries of such staff by 90 per cent of the movement of the consumer price index (CPI) for New York, whenever the CPI has increased by 5 per cent or more over the level reached at the time of the previous revision of the salary scale, or every 12 months, whichever comes first.

2. The CPI for the month of December 1998 reflects a 1.63 per cent movement over the December 1997 index. In application of the above-mentioned procedure, the net salaries of staff in the General Service, Language Teacher, Public Information Assistant, Security Service and Trades and Crafts categories will be adjusted upwards by 1.47 per cent, with effect from 1 January 1999.

3. Pursuant to General Assembly resolution 52/216 of 22 December 1997 regarding the revised methodology for determining salaries for locally recruited staff in the General Service and related categories, which came into effect as of 1 January 1998, the dependent children's allowance for locally recruited staff in the General Service and related categories is hereby revised to \$1,044 net per annum, effective 1 January 1999. The amount represents 2.5 per cent of the mid-point of the lowest and highest net salaries, that is, G-1/step 1 and S-7/step IX. It should be noted that this amount applies only to staff recruited on or after 1 February 1999, while the previous amount of \$1,236 remains payable to eligible staff on board and already in receipt of the higher amount prior to 1 February 1999.

4. The amount of other dependency allowances, that is, dependent spouse, secondary dependant and first dependent child of a single, widowed or divorced staff member, remain unchanged.

5. The amount of the first and second language allowances have been revised, effective 1 January 1999, to \$1,620 and \$810 net per annum, respectively.
6. The implementation of the revised salary scales, which are contained in the annex to the present circular, will be effective 1 January 1999, and will be reflected in the end of February 1999 payroll.
