SECURITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION 864 (1993) CONCERNING THE SITUATION IN ANGOLA

NOTE VERBALE DATED 8 FEBRUARY 1999 FROM THE PERMANENT OBSERVER MISSION OF SWITZERLAND TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE

The Permanent Observer Mission of Switzerland to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 864 (1993) and, with reference to his note verbale dated 21 July 1998, has the honour to inform him that on 25 November 1998 the Swiss Federal Council adopted an ordinance providing for the autonomous implementation of the measures set out in Security Council resolutions 864 (1993), 1127 (1997) and 1173 (1998).

While the measures contained in resolutions 864 (1993) and 1127 (1997) were in essence already covered by existing Swiss legislation, the extension of the measures taken to the areas of trade and finance by resolution 1173 (1998) made the adoption of a specific ordinance necessary. The ordinance entered into force on 26 November 1998.
