Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Mario MARTORELL (Peru)

- 1. At its 56th meeting, on 27 November 1981, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/36/162) concerning the vacancies which will occur in the Committee on Contributions as a result of the expiration on 31 December 1981 of the terms of office of six of its members.
- 2. The Fifth Committee also had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/36/51) containing the names of six persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment to the Committee on Contributions.
- 3. The Fifth Committee then decided, without a vote, to recommend Mr. Amjad Ali (Pakistan), Mr. Anatoly Semënovich Chistyakov (Union of Soviet Socialist Republics), Mr. Miguel Angel Dávila Mendoza (Mexico), Mr. Wilfried Koschorreck (Federal Republic of Germany), Mr. Yang Hushan (China) and Mr. Philippe Zeller (France) to the General Assembly for appointment as members of the Committee on Contributions for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 1982.
