## Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Mario MARTORELL (Peru)

- 1. At its 42nd meeting, on 16 November 1981, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/36/42) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolution A/36/L.16. The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/36/SR.42).

## DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

- 3. The Fifth Committee decided, by 76 votes to none, with 28 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/36/L.16, an additional appropriation of \$233,100 would be required under section 26 of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1982-1983.
- 4. Statements in explanation of vote were made by the representatives of Austria, Canada, Iraq, Mexico, Spain, Trinidad and Tobago, the United States of America and Yugoslavia.
