##### Addendum

1. As announced in paragraph 5 of his note dated 24 November 1981 (A/36/698/Rev.1), the President of the General Assembly has held the consultations described in article 3, paragraph 2, of the statute of the Joint Inspection Unit, including consultations with the President of the Economic and Social Council and with the Secretary-General in his capacity as Chairman of the Administrative Committee on Co-ordination. The replies received from the President of the Council and from the Secretary-General to identical letters addressed to them on 24 November 1981 by the President of the Assembly are attached (see annexes I and II).
2. Having completed the required consultations, the President of the General Assembly has the honour to submit to the Assembly the following list of candidates for appointment as members of the Joint Inspection Unit for a five-year term beginning on 1 January 1983:
