## Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Mario MARTORELL (Peru)

- 1. At its 52nd meeting, on 24 November 1981, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/36/43) on the administrative and financial implications of the draft resolution on the living conditions of the Palestinian people adopted by the Second Committee at its 35th meeting, on 11 November 1981 (A/36/694/Add.10, para. 18, draft resolution III). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/36/SR.52).

## DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by 81 votes to 2, with 14 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the Second Committee (A/36/694/Add.10, para. 18, draft resolution III), an additional appropriation of \$87,200 would be required under section 19 of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1982-1983.
