QUESTION OF THE COMPOSITION OF THE RELEVANT ORGANS OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Report of the Special Political Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Zahary RADOUKOV (Bulgaria)

1. The item entitled "Question of the composition of the relevant organs of the United Nations" was included in the provisional agenda of the thirty-sixth session of the General Assembly in accordance with Assembly decision 35/404 of 3 November 1980.

2. At its 4th plenary meeting, on 18 September 1981, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include the item in its agenda and to allocate it to the Special Political Committee.

3. At the 47th meeting of the Special Political Committee, on 2 December, the Chairman proposed that, as no member of the Committee had inscribed to speak on the item, consideration of it be deferred until the thirty-seventh session.

4. In the absence of objection, it was do decided.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE SPECIAL POLITICAL COMMITTEE

5. The Special Political Committee recommends that the General Assembly should include in the provisional agenda of its thirty-seventh session the item entitled "Question of the composition of the relevant organs of the United Nations".
