- 1. At its 68th meeting, on 9 December 1981, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/36/92) on the administrative and financial implications of the draft resolution recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 14 of its report (A/36/743). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/36/SR.68).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided without a vote to inform the General Assembly that should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 14 of its report (A/36/743), an additional appropriation of \$195,000 would be required under section 2 B (Department of Political and Security Council Affairs) of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1982-1983. Additional conference-servicing costs, not exceeding \$125,800, would be considered in the context of the consolidated paper of conference-servicing costs for 1982 at a later stage.
