Administrative and financial implications of draft resolution A recommended by the First Committee (A/36/756, para. 38)

Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 68th meeting, on 9 December 1981, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/36/93) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolution A recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 38 of its report (A/36/756). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/36/SR.68).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided without objection to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 38 of its report (A/36/756), an additional appropriation of \$55,000 would be required under section 2 B of the proposed programme budget for 1982-1983 (Department of Political and Security Council Affairs). Additional conference-servicing costs would arise in 1982-1983 not exceeding \$1,141,900. The 1982 portion, not exceeding \$319,400, would be considered at a later stage in the context of the consolidated statement of conference-servicing costs for 1982, and the remaining amount of \$822,500 for 1983 would be considered in the equivalent statement to be presented to the Assembly at its thirty-seventh session.
