1. At its 66th meeting, on 8 December 1981, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/36/70) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolution C recommended by the Special Political Committee in paragraph 27 of its report (A/36/632/Add.1). The observations of the Committee on Conferences are contained in document A/C.5/36/70/Add.1. The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/36/SR.66).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by 78 votes to 2, with 16 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution C recommended by the Special Political Committee in paragraph 27 of its report (A/36/632/Add.1), an

additional appropriation of \$283,200 would be required under section 23 of the proposed programme budget for 1982-1983. Provision in the amount of \$39,000 would also have to be made under section 31 (Staff assessment), to be offset by an increase in the same amount under income section 1 (Income from staff assessment). Additional conference-servicing costs not exceeding \$356,600 would arise, which would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of conference-servicing costs for 1982 at a later stage of the current session.
