PROPOSED PROGRAMME BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM 1982-1983

Administrative and financial implications of draft resolution II  
recommended by the Second Committee (A/36/694/Add.4, para. 9)Report of the Fifth CommitteeRapporteur: Mr. Mario MARTORELL (Peru)

1. At its 76th meeting, on 15 December 1981, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/36/101) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolution II recommended by the Second Committee in paragraph 9 of its report (A/36/694/Add.4). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (see A/C.5/36/SR.76).

## DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by 48 votes to 23, with 22 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution II recommended by the Second Committee in paragraph 9 of its report (A/36/694/Add.4), an additional appropriation of \$319,100 would be required under section 17 (United Nations Industrial Development Organization) of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1982-1983. Provision of \$35,800 would also have to be made under section 31 (Staff assessment), to be offset by an increase in the same amount under income section 1 (Income from staff assessment).
