Message from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Iraq to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to inform you that it has been established to the Iraqi competent authorities by eyewitness Iranian prisoners of war who have fallen to the Iraqi forces during the last battle at Khafjiyah, that the Iranian authorities murdered Iraqi prisoners of war taken in the said battle. The same shocking news was confirmed by a number of Iraqi military personnel who escaped captivity.

This hideous act constitutes a grave and ominous breach of the rules of international law and in particular the third Geneva Convention relative to the Treatment of Prisoners of War of 1949. These rules express the conscience of mankind as a whole. And the despicable act committed by the Iranian régime constitutes a crime against the human and civilized values of the international community.

Having violated its international obligation under the Charter by waging a war of aggression against Iraq, the Iranian régime has added the further grave breach of the rules pertaining to the treatment of prisoners of war. The Government of the Republic of Iraq, while reserving its right to pursue all avenues to protect its vital interests, considers that hideous crimes of the sort committed by the Iranian régime deserve not only the strongest condemnation but also concerted preventive action in the interest of human values which the Iranian régime has continuously defied.
