PROPOSED PROGRAMME BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM 1982-1983

REVISED ESTIMATES: EFFECT OF CHANGES IN RATES OF EXCHANGE

#### Report of the Secretary-General

- 1. In the foreword to the Proposed Programme Budget for the Biennium 1982-1983 a/, an indication was provided in paragraph 20 that before the General Assembly takes a final decision on the budget appropriations, further developments in exchange rates will be reviewed so as to ensure that the final approval is based on the most up-to-date assumptions at that time (see also para. 11 of the First Report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions on the Propsed Programme Budget for the Biennium 1982-1983, document A/36/7).
- 2. The above-mentioned review has been undertaken, in the light of which, it is proposed to update the exchange rates, as reflected in annex IV  $\underline{a}$ , for the following duty stations:

- Vienna (schillings)	from 13.30	to	15.50	for	one	US	dollar;
- The Hague (guilders)	from 2.05	to	2.52	**	"	**	••
- Bangkok (bahts)	from 20.15	to	22.90	n	17	**	•
- Nairobi (shillings)	from 7.33	to	10.50	11	"	**	11
- Rome (lire)	from 860	to	1,190	11	**	**	11

- 3. No adjustment is proposed of the dollar/Swiss franc rate of exchange in view of the small differential between the initially assumed rate of 1.71 Swiss francs to the dollar and the latest operational rate of 1.76 Swiss francs to the dollar.
- 4. The new rates have been applied to the amounts approved by the Fifth Committee in its first reading and to all amounts it has since approved. The effect of the recosting is shown in annex I.
- 5. As regards items still not approved by the Fifth Committee,
- (a) the consolidated statement of administrative and financial implications in respect of conference-servicing costs has been prepared on the basis of the new rates, and any amounts approved in this respect by the Fifth Committee will therefore not require recosting;
- (b) a number of revised estimates and financial implications are still pending at the time of the preparation of this report. A list of these is provided in annex II, at the current amounts. It is proposed that the amounts eventually approved for these items be recosted and reflected directly in the amounts proposed to the Fifth Committee on second reading.
- 6. The over-all effect of the recosting of the amounts referred to in paragraph 4 above can be summarized as follows:
