Administrative and financial implications of the draft resolution contained in document A/C.3/36/L.73/Rev.1

Statement submitted by the Secretary-General in accordance with rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly

- 1. At its 68th meeting on 1 December 1981, the Third Committee adopted the draft resolution contained in document A/C.3/36/L.73/Rev.l. It had before it a statement of administrative and financial implications (A/C.3/36/L.81).
- 2. Under operative paragraph 2 of the draft resolution contained in document A/C.3/36/L.73/Rev.1, the General Assembly would decide to establish, at its thirty-seventh session, an open-ended working group for the purpose of concluding the elaboration of the draft declaration on the human rights of individuals who are not citizens of the country in which they live.
- 3. Should the General Assembly adopt the draft resolution, the need for conference servicing requirements for the open-ended working group would arise. For the purpose of estimating the cost of those requirements, the following assumptions have been made:
- (a) The working group would meet twice a week for six weeks during the thirty-seventh session of the General Assembly;
- (b) Interpretation would be provided in Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Russian and Spanish;
- (c) The pre- and post-session documentation would be processed in Geneva; 81-34406

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- (d) The working group would report to the Third Committee of the General Assembly at its thirty-seventh session;
- (e) The substantive staff to service the working group would be provided by the Division of Human Rights.
- 4. In the light of the above assumptions, the conference servicing requirements, estimated on a full-cost basis, are \$217,000 as detailed in the annex to the present document. These would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of total conference servicing requirements to be submitted to the General Assembly towards the end of its current session.
