Administrative and financial implications of the draft resolution contained in document A/C.2/36/L.144 as orally corrected

Statement submitted by the Secretary-General in accordance with rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly

- 1. The Second Committee, at its 46th meeting held on 7 December 1981, adopted the draft resolution contained in document A/C.2/36/L.144 as orally corrected. A statement of administrative and financial implications was orally presented and has subsequently been issued as document A/C.2/36/L.144.
- 2. In operative paragraph 1 of the draft resolution contained in document A/C.2/36/L.144 as orally corrected, the General Assembly would decide to establish the long-term arrangements for the United Nations Financing System for Science and Technology for Development. Further, by operative paragraph 7 of the draft resolution, the General Assembly would request the Secretary-General to convene a pledging conference in the first quarter of 1982. The convening of such a conference would give rise to additional conference servicing costs estimated on a full-cost basis at \$52,400, as detailed in the annex below.
- 3. By operative paragraph 8 of the draft resolution, the General Assembly would decide that, without prejudice to the final agreement on the long-term institutional arrangements for the Financing System, the general operational provisions of the Interim Fund, including its resources, organization and management, as well as the procedures set forth in the annex to General Assembly resolution 34/218, would apply and be transferred to the Financing System during the transitional period. In consequence, the secretariat of the Interim Fund will become the secretariat of the Financing System during the transitional year under

the administration of the United Nations Development Programme. It is noted that the procedure followed for review and approval of the administrative budget of the secretariat of the Interim Fund was the submission of proposals of the Administrator of the United Nations Development Programme by the Secretary-General of the General Assembly, through the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (ACABQ), for review and approval. The Secretary-General intends to submit the Administrator's proposals for 1982 requirements to the Fifth Committee through the ACABQ at the present session of the Assembly. Such proposals would relate solely to extrabudgetary resources and no regular budget resources would be involved.

- 4. By operative paragraph 9 of the draft resolution, the General Assembly would decide that an Ad Hoc Intergovernmental Group of the Whole on the United Nations Financing System for Science and Technology for Development should hold two sessions in New York, the first, lasting one week, from 1 to 5 March 1982 and the second, lasting two weeks, from 12 to 23 April 1982. It is noted, in this connexion, that the General Assembly, by paragraph 1 of its resolution 35/5 of 20 October 1980 declared a temporary moratorium on the establishment of new intergovernmental organs. 1/ Should the General Assembly decide to adopt the decision to convene an Ad Hoc Intergovernmental Group of the Whole on the United Nations Financing System, an exception would thereby be made to the above-mentioned provision of General Assembly resolution 35/5.
- 5. The conference-servicing costs of the proposed meetings calculated on a full-cost basis would total \$294,300, as detailed in the annex to the present statement and summarized below:

It is assumed that the Office of Secretariat Services for Economic and Social Matters would provide the technical servicing for these meetings. With regard to substantive servicing of the meetings, it is noted that no specific provision has been made in the draft on this matter. It will be recalled in this regard, however, that General Assembly resolution 34/218 had made provision for the Intergovernmental Group of Experts on the United Nations Financing System for Science and Technology for Development to be supported by the Director-General for Development and International Economic Co-operation; the ad hoc intergovernmental group has a scope and mandate broadly similar to the Group of Experts. Substantive

servicing for the meetings will therefore be provided by the Office of the Director-General, drawing as necessary on the resources and expertise of the secretariat of the Financing System and the Centre for Science and Technology for Development. The costs of such technical and substantive servicing would be absorbed within existing resources.

- 6. It is noted, by the latter part of operative paragraph 9 of the draft resolution, that the General Assembly would decide that the time between the first and second sessions of the Ad Hoc Group should be fully utilized for consultations. The Secretary-General wishes to point out that, in accordance with firmly established practice, if conference servicing is required for such informal consultations, it would be made available on an "as and when available" basis. Accordingly, no additional expenditures are envisaged in respect of such servicing.
- 7. In summary, should the General Assembly adopt the resolution in document A/C.2/36/L.144 as orally adopted, additional conference-servicing costs calculated on a full-cost basis not exceeding an amount of \$346,700 would be required as follows:

These requirements will be reviewed in the context of a consolidated statement of total conference-servicing requirements to be submitted to the General Assembly at its thirty-sixth session. Accordingly, no additional appropriation is being requested at this point.
