## United States of America: revised draft resolution

The General Assembly,

Confirming its continued support for the development of evaluation systems and evaluation units within each agency,

<u>Emphasizing</u> support for the Joint Inspection Unit reports on evaluation in the United Nations system, 1/

Encouraging all agencies to co-operate with the Joint Inspection Unit in assuring the agency's evaluation capacity, in order to make evaluation an integral part of the agency's programming and development process,

1. <u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General to strengthen the United Nations evaluation systems and evaluation units by:

- specifying the responsibilities and tasks of the United Nations evaluation units;
- preparing for the General Assembly precise evaluation plans linked to the medium-term planning process and the budget cycle;
- developing guidelines for the planning and design of programmes and projects to improve their subsequent evaluability;

- designing and issuing basic standards for the conduct, content and process of evaluation and assuring that the quality of the evaluation products is continually assessed; and
- taking appropriate measures to ensure that evaluation findings are promptly and systematically utilized in the management decision-making process and that follow-up evaluation findings and recommendations are carried out;

2. <u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General to report to the thirty-seventh session of the General Assembly on the implementation of the foregoing paragraph.
