Union of Soviet Socialist Republics: amendments to revised draft resolution A/C.5/36/L.16/Pev.1

Insert the following three additional operative paragraphs after operative paragraph 1:

¹²2. <u>Appeals</u> to any Member State which has placed under arrest or detention a staff member of the United Mations or of a specialized or related agency to enable an official representative of the Member State of which the staff member is a national to visit and converse with him:

"3. Further requests the Secretary-General to make a comparative analysis of the levels of the privileges and immunities enjoyed by the staff members of the United Nations and the specialized agencies in the Member States in which the headquarters of these organizations are located, and to submit a report on this question to the General Assembly at its thirtyseventh session;

¹¹4. <u>Appeals</u> to the Governments of the Member States in which the headquarters of the United Nations and the specialized agencies are located to ensure that the levels of privileges and immunities granted to the staff members of these organizations are raised to the most favourable existing level¹¹.
