LETTER DATED 29 MAY 1999 FROM THE CHARGÉ D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF YUGOSLAVIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have been instructed by my Government to inform you that on 26 May 1999 the Stabilization Force in Bosnia and Herzegovina violated the border of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia. At 7.45 p.m., on the said date, six members of the Stabilization Force in two vehicles entered about 500 metres into the territory of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia in the vicinity of the village of Olandici, 10 kilometres south-west of Priboj. They were disarmed by the members of the unit of the Army of Yugoslavia guarding the border in that region. They were held till 2 a.m. the following day, after which they were returned over the border.

I should be grateful if you would have the ___sent letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
