SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF  
WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE  
REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in document S/14326 of 9 January 1981 and S/14326/Add.23 of 17 June 1981.

During the week ending 12 December 1981, the Security Council took no action on any of the items listed therein.

At its 2312th meeting, held in private on 11 December, 1981, the Security Council continued its consideration of the question on the recommendation for the appointment of the Secretary-General of the United Nations.

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued by the Secretary-General at the close of the meeting, in place of a verbatim record:

"At its 2312th meeting, held in private on 11 December 1981, the Security Council considered the question of the recommendation for the appointment of the Secretary-General of the United Nations.

"As a result of the voting on the candidates by secret ballot, the Security Council unanimously adopted the following resolution as resolution 494 (1981):

'The Security Council,

'Having considered the question of the recommendation for the appointment of the Secretary-General of the United Nations,

'Recommends to the General Assembly that Mr. Javier Pérez de Cuéllar be appointed Secretary-General of the United Nations for a term of office from 1 January 1982 to 31 December 1986."
