NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

At the 56th plenary meeting of its thirty-sixth session, on 13 November 1981, the General Assembly adopted resolution 36/27, entitled "Armed Israeli aggression against the Iraqi nuclear installations and its grave consequences for the established international system concerning the peaceful uses of nuclear energy, the non-proliferation of nuclear weapons and international peace and security".* In paragraphs 4 and 5 of that resolution, the General Assembly

"4. <u>Requests</u> the Security Council to investigate Israel's nuclear activities and the collaboration of other States and parties in those activities;

"5. <u>Reiterates its request</u> to the Security Council to institute effective enforcement action to prevent Israel from further endangering international peace and security through its acts of aggression and continued policies of expansion, occupation and annexation".
